2. Young Generation Forum(YGF) · Young Professional Forum(YPF)

□ Details

○ Date : 2023.7.3. ~ 2023.7.7., 4 nights and 5 days

○ Location : Seoul Hotel Samjung

○ **Eligibility Requirements** :

- (YGF) Current undergraduate students with a science, engineering, or technology-related major and an ability to communicate effectively in English or Korean(**Born in 1997 or later**)

- (YPF) Current graduate students or post-doctoral researchers with a science or engineering major and an ability to communicate effectively in English or Korean(**Born in 1988 or later**)

※ Post-doctoral researchers must have earned their doctoral degrees within 5 years

○ Target Participants : About **150 Person**

- (YGF) 70 Overseas Participants*, 20 Domestic Participants

- (YPF) 40 Overseas Participants*, 20 Domestic Participants

* Overseas Participants : 1.5, 2nd or later generation young scientists and engineers with overseas citizenship or a permanent residency, excluding Korean nationals studying abroad

○ Support Details :

- Part of round-trip airfares* and entire accommodation expenses for 5 days

* Airfares are only available for receipt with the payment amount stated, NOT available for mileage ticket.

- Traveler's insurance fee* during the YGF·YPF period

* All overseas participants must purchase travel insurance before departure, and only receipts with a guarantee period specified as the YGF-YPF period (July 3 to July 7) is available.

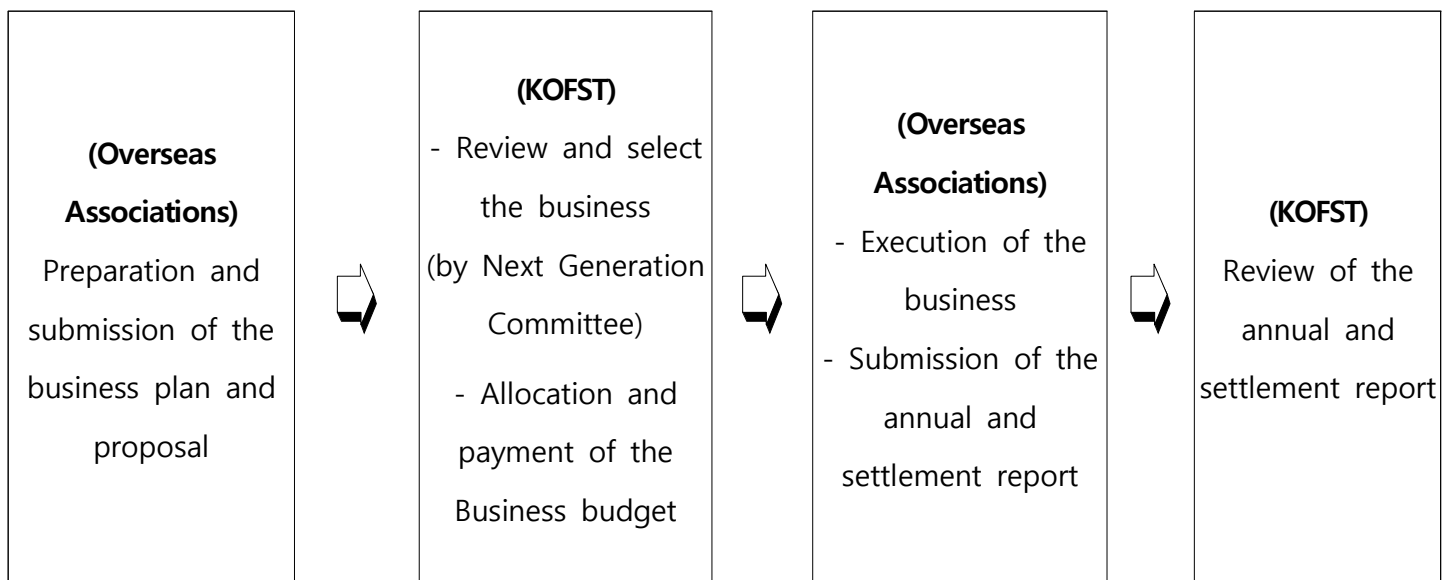

- Business Contents : Forums, Workshops, Symposiums, etc. for the Next generation which are developed by the Overseas S&T Association
- Project Period : 2023.4.1.(After an agreement) ~ 2023.12.31.
- Business Target : 19 Overseas S&T Associations undergoing next generation support programs
- Support Scale : Up to **2 programs** per each association
- Support Details : Part of the cost of hosting a program

※ If the business plan or proposal is not submitted within the deadline, the application will be considered to have been waived.

○ Application Method :

- Submit the application **by E-mail**

※ A application overlapping with Special Business will not be allowed.

○ Necessary Document :

- 2023 Next Generation S&T Leaders Exchange and Cooperation Application form

○ Final Selection :

- Evaluation results of the Next Generation Committee of KOFST will be reflected for differentiated support.

- The final selected Overseas Associations have to sign an Agreement and payment will proceed after agreement.

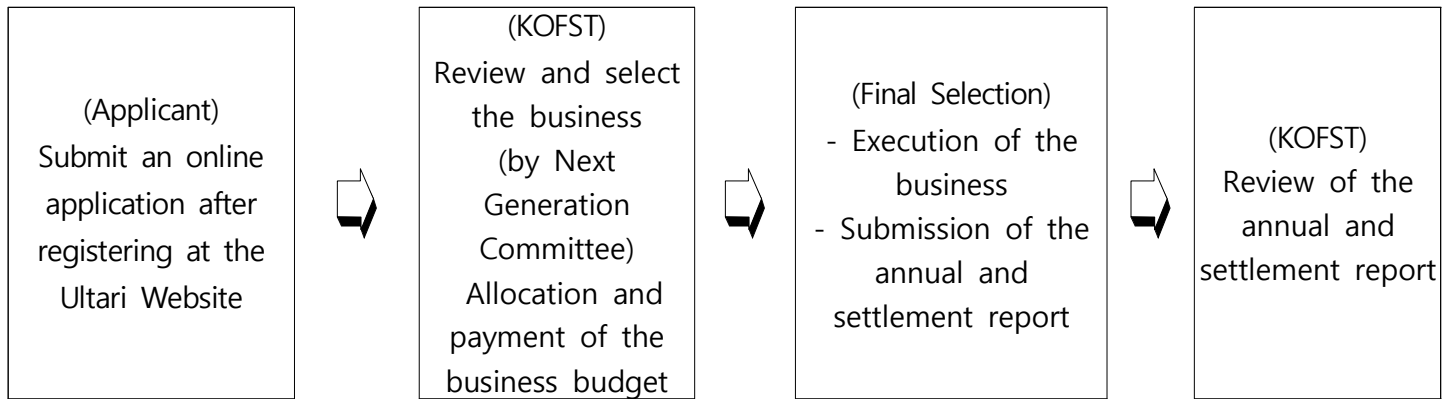

4. Next Generation S&T Leaders Net

□ Details

- Business Contents : Support for small research meetings in the same or similar fields
- Project Period : 2023.4.1.(After an agreement) ~ 2023.12.1.
- Business Target :
 - A small group of 3~6 people conducting academic activities for science and technology-related research fields, convergence, and startups
 - ※ Groups that research Environmental, Renewable, and Health-related fields will be considered first.
- Eligibility Requirements :
 - Master's / doctoral students, and Post-doctoral researchers of Korean heritage in the fields of natural sciences and engineering who reside overseas including Korean students currently studying abroad.
 - ※ The positions are available to those who are born in 1988 or later. Post-doctoral researchers must have earned their doctoral degrees within 5 years.
 - Each group must be comprised of 3 to 6 members in similar fields who reside in the same city.
 - The applicants have to be either **existing members of Overseas Associations** or those who have newly joined such associations.
- Support Scale : About 25 Group
- Support Details : Up to 2 million KRW for each group
 - Part of the cost of hosting a Seminar or meeting(Each group has to hold at least 4 seminars regularly during the duration of the project)
 - Expenses for group activities(Travel Expenses, Cost of Expert Assistance, Meeting Expenses, etc.)

○ Application Period : 2023.2.1. ~ 2023.3.17.

※ The application will not be completed until you click on the application complete button after inserting the relevant information online and attaching the required documents. Any applications that do not mark the completion will not be accepted.

○ Application Method : Online Application * www.ultari.org , 차세대NET – 신청하기

- **Every member of the group must first join the Ultari Website and insert the relevant information.**
- **Each group's leader should write their activity plan as the representative** of the group.
- As the CV of each member must be uploaded when applying, the leader should collect the CVs for all members of the group before submitting the application.
- Certificates for every member must be attached to confirm their membership in the relevant overseas associations.

○ Final Selection :

- Evaluation results of the Next Generation Committee of KOFST will be reflected.
- The final selected Group have to sign an Agreement and payment will proceed after agreement.

○ Payment of Bussiness Budget

- **Overseas Associations** will transfer the budget to **leader's accounts** of selected groups.

Business Settlement

- Net Activity Research Results Report(Submitted by Leader)
- Expense Result Report
- Seminar(Meeting) Record

○ Fund Management

- The group selected for this project must record and manage its income and expenditure after receiving the support fund (must attach receipts to the Expense Result Report)
- If the support fund is improperly used or the objective of the project is not fulfilled, all or part of the fund shall be retrieved and the applicants shall be subject to eligibility restrictions for a given period.
